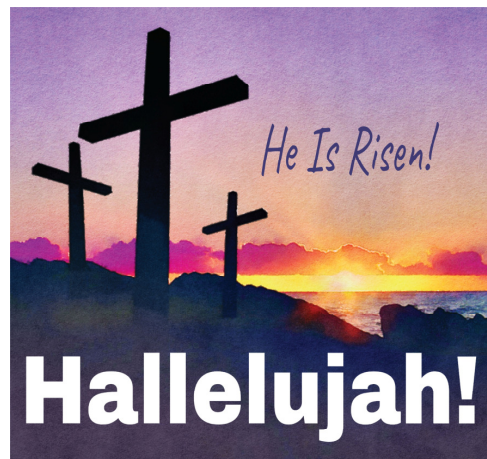

## From Pastor Jeff's Desk

Dear Faithbridge Family!

Please enjoy the following devotional from A.W. Tozer's *Pursuit of God*.

***"Then shall we know, if we follow on to know the LORD: His going forth is prepared as the morning; and He shall come to us as the rain, as the latter and former rain unto the earth."***  
-- Hosea 6:3

Christian theology teaches the doctrine of prevenient grace, which, briefly stated, means that before a man can seek God, God must first have sought the man.

Before a sinful man can think a right thought of God, there must have been a work of enlightenment done within him. Imperfect it may be, but a true work nonetheless, and the secret cause of all desiring and seeking and praying which may follow.

We pursue God because, and only because, He has first put an urge with us that spurs us to the pursuit. 'No man can come to me,' said our Lord, 'except the Father which hath sent me draw him,' and it is by this prevenient drawing that God takes from us every vestige of credit for the act of coming. The impulse to pursue God originates with God, but the outworking of that impulse is our following hard after Him.

May we pursue hard after God in developing a growing and meaningful relationship with Him. He has made the way possible through Christ and the indwelling of the Holy Spirit. Ours is to enjoy His presence daily by faith through the access He has provided. As we pursue God we shall become more like Him, which is, after all, the goal of our relationship with Him, to His glory. For additional mediation, consider Psalm 42:1-2.

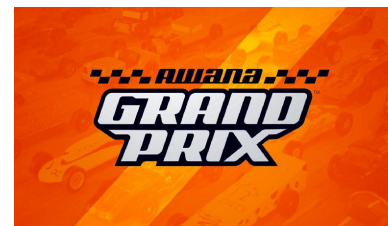

### Those Nasty Ticks!

Yes, we're almost in the thick of the tick season once again, with Spring coming a bit earlier than usual this year. They're out of hibernation and ready to attack! For most of you who have lived in this area for any length of time, you're probably well aware of the dangers of tick bites. This will serve as a review and a reminder of their profound effects on our health if we let our guard down by refraining from vigilance. Check yourself, children and pets after all outdoor activities.



There are three types of ticks to be aware of: the black-legged (deer) tick, the Lone Star tick and the American dog tick. All of these can potentially cause serious illnesses, no matter where in the U.S. you live or visit. Their bites can result in a variety of illnesses and if left untreated can have long-lasting or life-threatening effects. Common illnesses include: Lyme disease, Human ehrlichiosis and anaplasmosis, Babesiosis, and Tularemia. 

Most infections cause flu-like symptoms— fever, chills, headache, joint pain and stomach upset. If caught early, oral antibiotics often prevent complications. Depending on which tick is the culprit, additional symptoms may appear such as a rash, dark urine, jaundice, eye redness and tearing, cough, or chest pain.


If you find a tick on your skin, remove it as quickly as possible using these tips:

- Grasp the tick as close to your skin as possible, using tweezers if available.
- Pull upward with a steady motion, trying not to twist or jerk the tick.
- After removal, clean the area with alcohol or soap and water.
- Save the tick in a plastic bag in case you later develop symptoms and see doctor.

Prevention is key— spray skin with a DEET repellent before most outdoor activity.

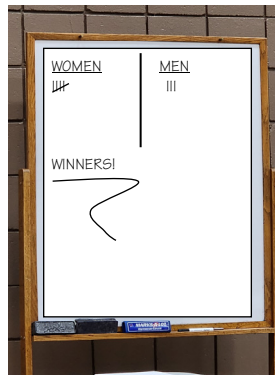
