Dear Faithbridge Family,

Let us hear the words from David in Psalm 86:5-7, ESV, *“For You, O Lord, are good and forgiving, abounding in steadfast love to all who call upon You. Give ear, O Lord, to my prayer; listen to my plea for grace. In the day of my trouble I call upon You, for You answer me.”*

It is a good reminder that David declares the goodness and forgiveness of our God. God’s goodness and forgiveness is grounded in His steadfast—which means persistent and never-changing—love to *“all who call upon You.”* We need to pay attention to that qualification *“all who call upon You”* because it would be easy to overlook it or pass it by and incorrectly draw the conclusion that God abounds in steadfast love for all people regardless of their relationship with Him, even the unregenerate.

Now, God does love the unregenerate and He demonstrated that love through the sending of His one and only Son. But if the unregenerate remain in their sin, unrepentant and unforgiven, then they will remain spiritually dead and lost upon their physical death. This is not because God is unloving toward them; quite the opposite. It is because of the hardness of their own hearts.

David continues to say, *“Give ear, O Lord, to my prayer; listen to my plea for grace.”* The repentant and regenerate know that they can always call upon the Lord. God’s people know that He not only hears us when we cry for grace, but He listens! We can have great confidence that our God listens to us when we call out to Him.

Not only does God listen, He answers our pleas. David completes his thought with *“In the day of my trouble I call upon You, for You answer me.”* The challenge for us is that God does not always answer us in the way that we’d like Him to, especially in the *“day of [our] trouble.”* Typically we find ourselves in trouble because of our own choosing, whether through foolishness or ignorance or willful rebellion against God. And then we look to God to bail us out of consequences that we rightfully deserve. In those situations, He still listens, and He still answers, but the answer most likely will be to endure the consequences and learn from your mistakes so you don’t make them again.

However, sometimes we do find ourselves in trouble outside of our own making. People are sinning against us, hurting us, taking advantage of us, etc. Cry out to the Lord knowing He listens, and He will answer; He will provide a way of escape and protection, even vindication. And as we cry out to Him, may we seek His glory and honor, depending on Him!



LET'S GO OUTSIDE!

After a long Winter season of being mostly indoors, it's time to get outside and get active again. The benefits of outdoor physical activity and a regular fitness routine are enormous. One major bonus is that it boosts our immune system and protects against illness. Let's build a healthy immunity to whatever may be coming in the Fall and the next cold and flu season.



Physical activity refers to any body movement that burns calories, such as mowing the lawn, walking up stairs, gardening, walking the dog, playing a game or sport to name a few. Exercise is a more structured form involving a series of repetitive movements designed to strengthen or develop some part of the body. Both forms are valuable to your health. The important thing is to keep moving.

If you have trouble carving out 30 minutes of your day for a specific activity, such as walking or bicycling, try another approach. Here are some suggestions:

- * Instead of sitting and talking with a friend, go for a walk together.
- * Play with your kids or grandkids instead of watching them play.
- * Park in the farthest parking spot from the building you're going to.
- * Climb the stairs instead of taking the elevator.
- * When watching television, use a stationary bike, treadmill or lift free weights
- * Spend time in the garden, rake leaves, prune bushes.



Make outdoor activity fun for the whole family:

- * Take the kids on an adventurous treasure hunt.
- * Have them run like a gorilla, fly like a bee, walk like a spider or bunny hop.
- * Play tag, 'Simon Says', or kickball.
- * Plan vacations around hiking, swimming, skiing, or camping.



Physically active people are healthier, stronger, leaner, more flexible, and have greater endurance and lung capacity. Additionally, they are more mentally alert, sleep better, are sick less often and bounce back more quickly when they do catch a bug. Regular activity also relieves symptoms of depression, stress and anxiety. So let's get up and get going. Have a wonderfully active and healthy Summer!

New Books Coming in June

Anxious for Nothing: God's Cure for the Cares of Your Soul - Pastor John MacArthur believes that peace is not only possible, it's a divine mandate. Together, Amalia and Ruth trek to Iowa to claim the farm and former boarding house that Ruth has inherited, despite opposition from a difficult cousin. Struggling with an empty house and scarce resources, Amalia resolves to return the boardinghouse to its former purpose, aided by the kindness of strangers and the resilient spirit of her young charge. With each challenge they face, Amalia and Ruth find hope in believing that faith and determination can overcome even the most daunting of trials.

The Keeper (A Murphy Shepherd Novel) - Bones--Murphy Shepherd's teacher, mentor, priest, and friend--is gone. Devastated by the loss Murph has no choice but to jump back into work when the worst happens. Murph's longtime friend, silent partner against trafficking, and current United States vice president, Aaron Ashley's three daughters have been taken without a clue or trace--just an empty house, a bereft mother, and nine dead Secret Service agents.


