"The proverbs of Solomon, son of David, king of Israel: To know wisdom and instruction, to understand words of insight, to receive instruction in wise dealing, in righteousness, justice, and equity; to give prudence to the simple, knowledge and discretion to the youth—Let the wise hear and increase in learning, and the one who understands obtain guidance, to understand a proverb and a saying, the words of the wise and their riddles. The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instruction" – Proverbs 1:1-7, ESV.

Proverbs is a collection of wisdom sayings from many of the wise in Israel's history, though most famously the wise sayings of Solomon, son of David, king of Israel. In the opening lines of Proverbs we are introduced to Solomon who is responsible for nearly 29 chapters of wisdom sayings. Chapter 30 features the words of Agur, another wise man, and Chapter 31 are the words of King Lemuel. Proverbs can best be characterized as practical, righteous wisdom on how to live in right relationship with God and with others.

And that is what the opening lines of Proverbs, chapter one, promise. With these proverbs one will learn to know wisdom and instruction. Wisdom is defined as *"good sense"* or as I like to think of it *"knowledge rightly applied to life."* Instruction is the ability to be humble enough to learn how to do something from someone else. Seeking instruction, or being teachable, seems to be less and less popular these days. Rather than admitting we don't know how to do something we'd rather look it up on YouTube than to ask another person for their help and to teach us.

The wisdom contained in Proverbs also helps us understand *"words of insight"*, that is wisdom, which is essentially saying that wisdom helps us understand wisdom. When we seek wisdom and to grow in our understanding of wisdom Proverbs informs us that we will grow in our wisdom. This is true of any other area of our lives. If I want to grow stronger, then I need to lift heavier weights. If I want to run farther and faster, then I need to go out and run. We do those things that we want to grow and improve in. Simple enough, right? Then why do we seem to struggle so much with it?

Furthermore, Proverbs promises to increase a person's wisdom in dealing with others, in what is righteous, just and equitable towards other people. It also gives *"prudence to the simple"*, which really means to have the ability to govern and discipline oneself with the use of reason and to exercise good judgment in the use of resources. This is something that we all can use a lot more of in our lives! (continued on next page)

In verse 5 we read, *“Let the wise hear and increase in learning...”* Those who are considered wise are only wise because they are willing to learn and do not pretend to know it all. Actually, it is the fool who despises wisdom and instruction (v. 7). And the beginning of wisdom, the foundation and ground of it? It starts with the fear of the LORD, knowing that there is a God in heaven who created all things and holds all things together by the word of His mouth. Acknowledging that God is Creator and that we are created is the beginning of wisdom.

And as His kids, our wisdom begins with our knowledge of God as our Heavenly Father and that salvation only comes through the Lord Jesus Christ, His Son. With that knowledge rightly applied to our lives, we are well on our way on the pathway of growing in wisdom and grace. Would you join me in reading through Proverbs this month to grow deeper in your wisdom?

UNDERSTANDING GRIEF

Losing a loved one is one of the most distressing and, unfortunately, common experiences people face. Most people experiencing normal grief and bereavement have a period of sorrow, numbness, and even guilt and anger. Gradually these feelings ease, and it's possible to accept loss and move forward.

For some people, feelings of loss are debilitating and don't improve even after time passes. This is known as complicated grief when painful emotions are so long lasting and severe that you have trouble recovering from the loss and resuming your own life.

Different people follow varied paths through the grieving experience. The order and timing of these phases may vary from person to person, but it's important for everyone to do the following:

- * Accept the reality of your loss.
- * Allow yourself to experience the pain of your loss.
- * Adjust to a new reality in which the deceased one is absent.
- * Begin to focus more on existing and possibly new relationships.

Risk factors for developing complicated grief include:

- * An unexpected or violent death of a loved one (accident, murder or suicide).
- * Death of a child.
- * Close or dependent relationship to the deceased person.
- * Social isolation or loss of a support system or friendships.
- * Past history of depression or post-traumatic stress disorder.
- * Traumatic childhood experiences (abuse or neglect).
- * Other major stressors, such as financial hardship.

Without appropriate treatment, complicated grief can lead to depression, suicidal thoughts, anxiety, sleep disturbances, difficulty performing tasks of daily living, substance misuse or abuse or increased risk of physical illness.

Prevention strategies for severe complicated grief may include talking about your grief and allowing yourself to cry; family/friend support and your local faith community; bereavement counseling one-on-one or in a group setting.

Many communities worldwide have **GriefShare** programs (*see page 14*) that are free of charge to redirect individuals toward answers found in the Word of God. After all—Jesus himself wept at the death of His beloved friend Lazarus (John chapt.11). We offer such a program here at Faithbridge—please join us if or when you find yourself struggling with grief due to the death of a loved one. No one should try to 'go it alone'. Seek the strength that comes only from the Lord.
