## KNOWING GOD LOVES YOU

*“The Lord your God in your midst, the Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing.” - Zephaniah 3:17*

I remember a day a few years ago when I was talking with someone who kept quoting Zephaniah 3:17. He was deeply impacted by the words in this verse to the point that he could not withhold his emotions. What was interesting about this conversation was that this man had spent his life in the ministry, serving in various capacities from missionary to seminary professor. He knew the Lord, walked with Him, talked with Him and loved Him with all of his heart, but did he really understand how much God loved Him?

The same is true for many of us today. We proclaim our love for the Lord. We pray to know Him more. We deeply desire a life that is fruitful and pleasing to Him. And for the most part, I believe that we spend more time thinking and praying about how to please God and how to live our lives in accordance with His will, than we spend thinking about how much He loves us. How often do you personally stop and think, “God loves me...He is rejoicing over me right now”? We tend to think that God is disappointed or upset with us instead of thinking about how much He loves and adores us. Why? Because so much of our thought processes are shaped by the world, not by the love of God. And we have an enemy who feeds right into those negative thoughts and will do anything he can to keep us from experiencing that peace and joy that comes from Jesus.

I encourage you today to write down this verse, meditate on it, and memorize it. Keep repeating it over in your heart and mind and let the Lord Himself speak these words into the depths of your soul. The Lord God is with you and will save you. He rejoices over you, quiets you with His love and sings to you. Can you believe it? Yes! God’s

Word is truth and you can trust that these words are spoken just for you. The man who spent his life in ministry was on the brink of retirement before he finally realized the truth of these words. Jesus wants you to know this truth today. Experience His love, peace and joy right now.

## FIVE RED FLAG WARNING SIGNS

—the 'FACES' of Heart Failure

Heart failure occurs when something reduces the heart's ability to pump your blood effectively. Most often, the damage stems from coronary artery disease (CAD) or heart attack. In addition, faulty heart valves, long-term high blood pressure, or genetic disease may also be to blame.

To help spot a possible combination of heart failure symptoms, the Heart Failure Society of America ([www.HFSA.org](http://www.HFSA.org)) has developed a handy tool that goes by the acronym FACES. By themselves, these five warning signs do not confirm a diagnosis of heart failure, but they do convey a sense of urgency to seek medical advice. If you experience any of these signs, cut out this handy checklist to discuss with your doctor.

- F** Fatigue. When the heart can't pump enough oxygen-rich blood to meet the body's energy needs, a general feeling of tiredness or fatigue sets in.
- A** Activity. People with heart failure are often unable to do their normal activities because they become easily tired and short of breath.
- C** Congestion. Fluid buildup in the lungs can result in coughing, wheezing, and breathing difficulties.
- E** Edema (ankle swelling). When the heart becomes too weak or stiff to pump blood out to the body, fluid can back up and collect in the ankles, lower legs, and abdomen. This excess fluid may cause rapid weight gain.
- S** Shortness of breath. Fluid in the lungs makes it more difficult for carbon dioxide in the 'used' blood to be exchanged for fresh oxygen. It may also be harder to breathe when lying down, because gravity allows fluid from lower in the body to travel up and into the lungs.

Your cardiovascular system is complex—with a lot of moving parts. Heart failure is just one of dozens of heart and vascular problems you could potentially face during your lifetime, especially as you grow older. Cardiovascular disease is the leading cause of death in the United States, accounting for 1 out of 3 deaths. The good news is that there is state-of-the-art testing available and many new medications on the market to treat the symptoms. So check with your physician and stay informed!

**Boot Camp:** Equipping Men with Integrity for Spiritual Warfare by Jason Hardin-- A spiritual guide that equips men with tools for spiritual warfare, using military boot camp metaphors to teach integrity and faith-based principles for personal growth.

**Serving God Under Siege: How War Transformed a Ukrainian Community** by Valentyn Syniy-- In this searing eye-witness account, Valentyn Syniy recounts how the Russian invasion of Ukraine in 2022 upended life for students, teachers and staff of the Tavriski Christian Institute. Displaced and dispossessed, TCI courageously embraced new forms of Christian faith. Syniy's book is a must read for those who care about the global church and want to understand the human cost of the war in Ukraine.

**A Hobbit, A Wardrobe and A Great War** by Joseph Loconte-- Deepen your insight into and appreciation for the writings of J.R.R Tolkien and C.S. Lewis as you explore the untold story of how the First World War shaped their lives, faith, and writings. Had there been no Great War, there would have been no Hobbit, no Lord of the Rings, no Narnia-- perhaps even no conversation of Christianity by C.S. Lewis.

**Living Beyond Offense:** Doing the Hard Work of Forgiveness God's Way by Yana Jenay Conner-- This book explores Jesus' teachings about forgiveness-- what it is, how to do it and what you gain when you put it into practice.

**The Mark of a Christian** by Emlen S. Garrett-- Provides Biblical insights into matters often misunderstood in today's church. Areas such as the Trinity, baptism, prayer, generational curses, Christian giving and more are dealt with in a straightforward, easy to read manner. The author's depth of knowledge concern-

ing the Bible and his ability to explain difficult issues in simple language makes this book a must for all who claim the title of Christian.

•**The Collector of Burned Books** by Roseanna M. White-- In this gripping World War II historical about the power of words, two people form an unlikely friendship amid the Nazi occupation in Paris and fight to preserve the truth that enemies of freedom long to destroy.

•**Season 5 of the Chosen Series**-- The table is set. The people of Israel welcome Jesus as king while His disciples anticipates His crowning. But-- instead of confronting Rome-- He turns the tables on the Jewish religious festival. Their power threatened, the country's religious and political leaders will go to any length to ensure this Passover meal is Jesus' last.

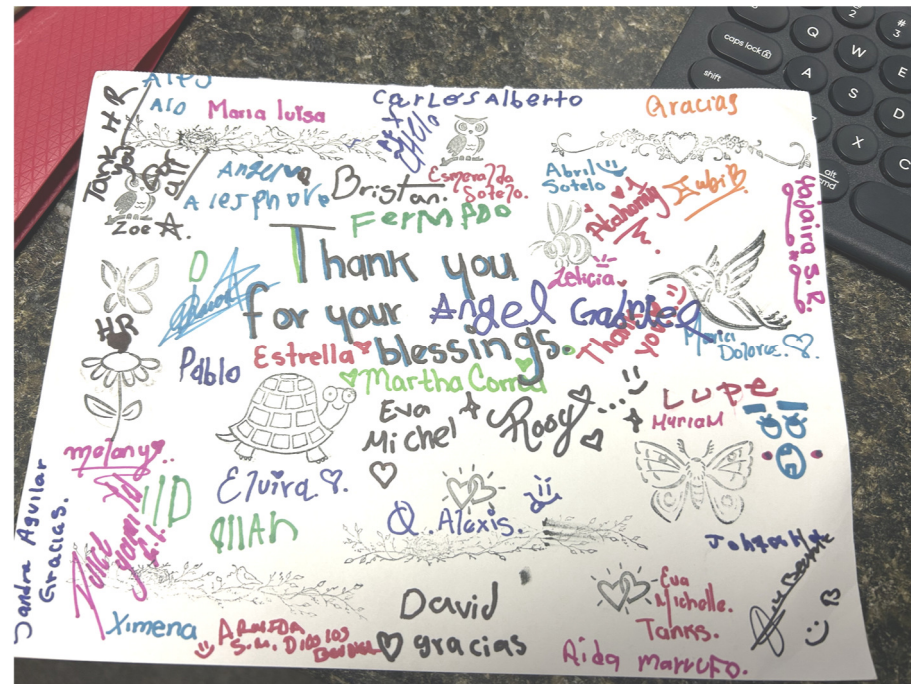
