## JOYFUL APPRENTICE

One who gladly embraces the call to worship Jesus and become more like him.

1. What joy or gratitude is rising in you as you walk with Jesus, even in the midst of life's challenges?
2. Where is Jesus inviting you to trust him today, either by letting go or stepping into something new?

## GENEROUS FRIEND

One who cultivates meaningful relationships by creating a welcoming and authentic environment.

1. Who in this season are you following Jesus with and what are you learning from them?
2. Where is there a relationship that has become distant, bruised, or broken? What step is the Lord inviting me to take to close that gap?

## COMPASSIONATE NEIGHBOR

One who welcomes and invites others into their humble walk with Jesus.

1. Who are you praying for to experience the love of God, and how might He be inviting you to take the next step toward them?
2. Who have you slowed down to truly listen to lately? What transition, trial, or tension surfaced in their story that is an open door to be and share the good news?

## COURAGEOUS INVESTOR

One who equips and encourages others to grow in their walk with Jesus and multiply His way of life in others.

1. Who are you investing in right now, and what has brought you the most joy or challenge in that journey?
2. What fresh encouragement or coaching do those you've disciplined currently need in order to keep investing in others?

# LORD, RENEW ME

A quick, daily guide to reading and applying God's Word

## Check your pulse!

Take a few deep breaths. Allow yourself to be present with God. Then, sit for a moment in the following two questions.



**Gratitude:** Where am I experiencing the light of God's presence, provision, and/or peace?



**Burden:** What/who is weighing on my heart or clouding my joy and peace?

## Attune your heart!



Give to God both the holy and the hard. Invite His Spirit to open your eyes to see wonderful things in His Word as you renew your soul with His presence.

## Open God's Word!

As you open God's word, journal and/or take note of what the passage - directly or indirectly - reveals about:



- Who is God? (Father, Son, Spirit)
- What has He done, is doing or will do?
- Who am I/are we?
- Therefore, what will I do?

## Connect the Dots!



Reflect on what God is revealing through His Word and Spirit. What connects to, informs or provides perspective to what you're experiencing in life? Pause and talk to Him about that.

## Step into life!



Pray something like: "Thank You Father for this time. As I step out into life, transform me into an Everyday Apprentice and don't let me miss the adventures you're bringing my way to speak life and speak the good news about Jesus today.
